The CPTED concept emphasizes the relationship of the physical environment, the productive use of space, and the behavior of people. Upon completion of this 24-hour course and successful completion of a written test, attendees become a NASRO Certified CPTED Practitioner. The course will include a hands-on CPTED evaluation of a school, and attendees will be provided with tools to use on their school campus or in their associated activities with school safety. The course goals are:

- Develop expertise in the practice of school CPTED
- Develop a common language and understanding of School CPTED for enhanced communications with other professionals and practitioners.
- Develop expertise in the use of the Centers for Disease Control CPTED School Assessment (CSA)
- Meet the prerequisite for NASRO School CPTED Practitioner Certification
